

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
East Anglia and southeast England windy with rain for a time, elsewhere sunny spells and scattered showers, these mostly across northern and western areas. Later many places across the UK becoming dry and sunny. Generally breezy and feeling cold. Overnight cloud and outbreaks of rain will spread across Scotland and western areas, locally heavy. Eastern locations remaining dry, becoming cold.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday cloud and outbreaks of rain continuing east to reach all areas. The rain, locally heavy, will clear southwards from much of Scotland by late evening. Sunday dry and fine across the north half of the UK, wet further south.
