Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
The north and west will be showery. Wintry showers in the north will give accumulations of snow and blizzards on high ground and it will be cold a frost expected in places at first. Southern and eastern areas mostly dry and sunny and temperatures will rise to near normal. A windy day, with gales in the north.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Sometimes-heavy rain with gale-force in northern parts on Monday, the south mainly dry. It will become mild, but the wind will give a chilly feel. Locally-heavy rain and gales will cross all parts from the northwest on Tuesday, temperatures dropping quickly after a mild start.
