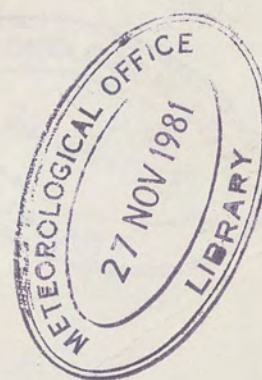

Gust of 57 knots on 9th is an October record.

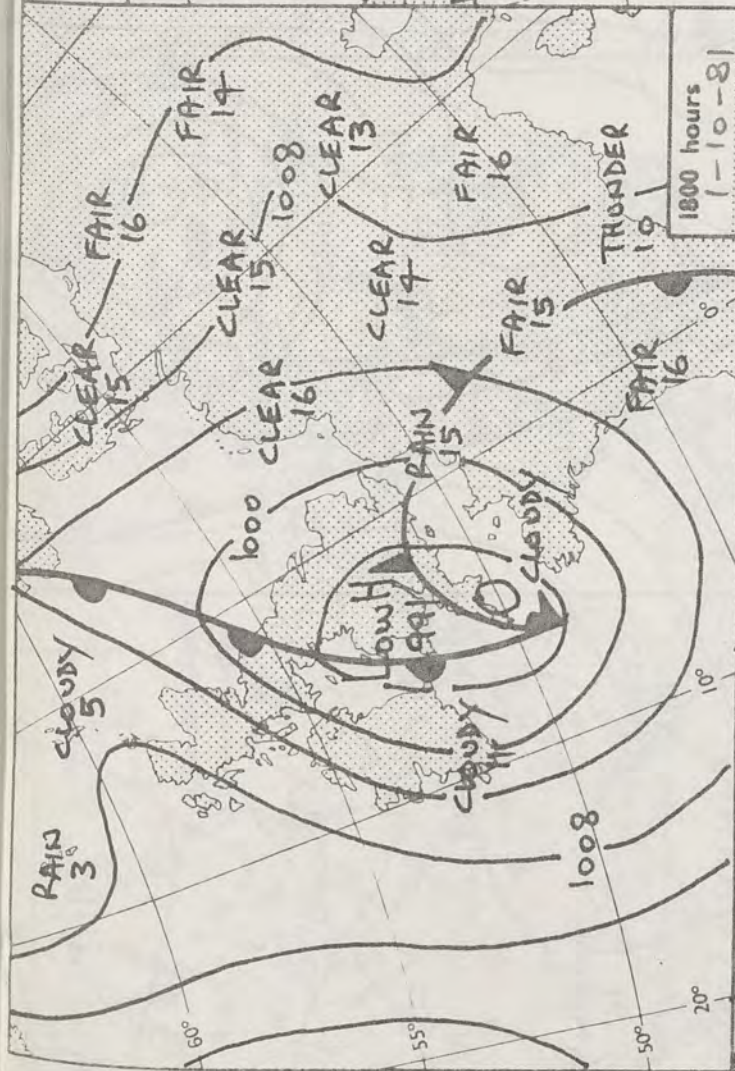

SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

Most of central and eastern England after occasional rain overnight, was dry much of the day and in East Anglia and SE England there were sunny intervals. SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER
Much of England and East Wales had a rather cloudy day with showers but also sunny intervals. Although the day began mild with a moderate south or south-westerly breeze, a short spell of rain moved east across most parts by lunchtime bringing with it cooler weather with SW or westerly winds. West Wales, the Isle of Man, Northern Ireland, northern-most parts of England and much of Scotland had a dull, cold very wet day with periods of heavy rain and sleet or snow at times on the mountains. Some high level roads were blocked by snow for a time. It was very windy in the west with northerly winds reaching storm force in the evening.

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SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

Scotland had a cold night with frost in places and isolated thundery showers but continuous rain in Shetland. Showers were widespread by day with continuous rain in the north where there were gales, severe in Shetland, England and Northern Ireland were showery with strong westerly winds and a good deal of sunshine. SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

In northern Scotland there were scattered showers and clear or sunny periods but cloudier conditions and more persistent rain spread northward to most of the mainland during the evening. Over the rest of the UK there were outbreaks of rain overnight heavy at times in western and northern regions while in SE England amounts of rain were small. SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER
Overnight there were outbreaks of rain, heaviest in Scotland, but showery conditions spread east and north to real all parts by or soon after dawn. During the day there were sunny intervals and squally showers, and in northern Scotland some more persistent rain. There were thunderstorms and hail in places during the afternoon. South-westerly winds became strong overnight in southern Britain and increased to severe gale force during the day over Wales, central and southern England with gusts over 70 knots around the Bristol Channel and over 60 knots inland. During the evening winds veered W to NW and gales extended to much of NW Britain.

SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

In most parts of the country it was a dry, clear night, but scattered showers continued to affect north and west facing coasts. 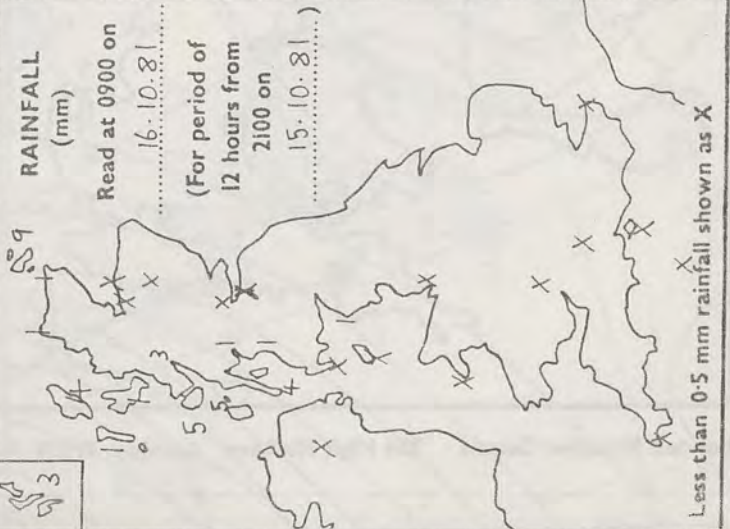






UPPER AIR CHART FOR 1200 HOURS

SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

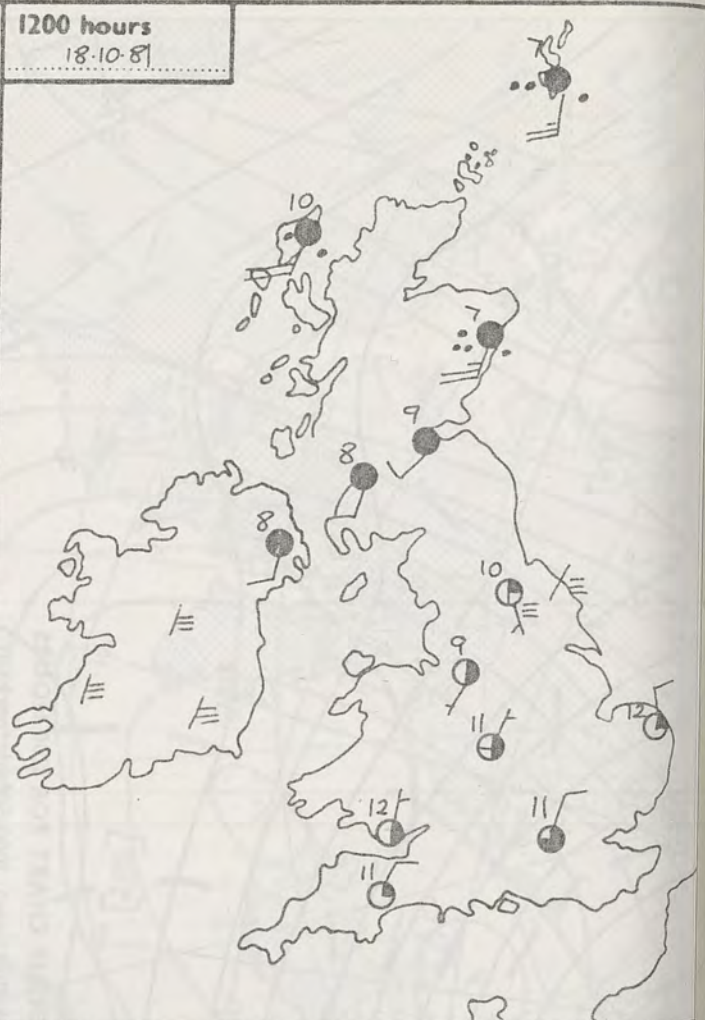


SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

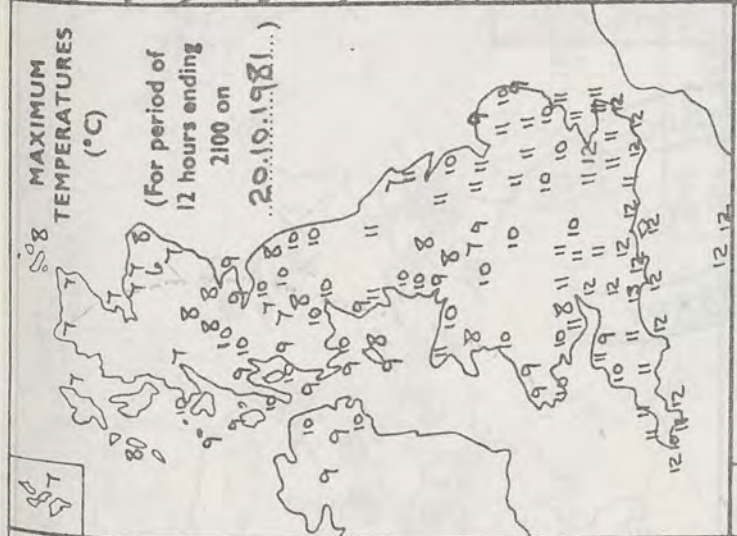
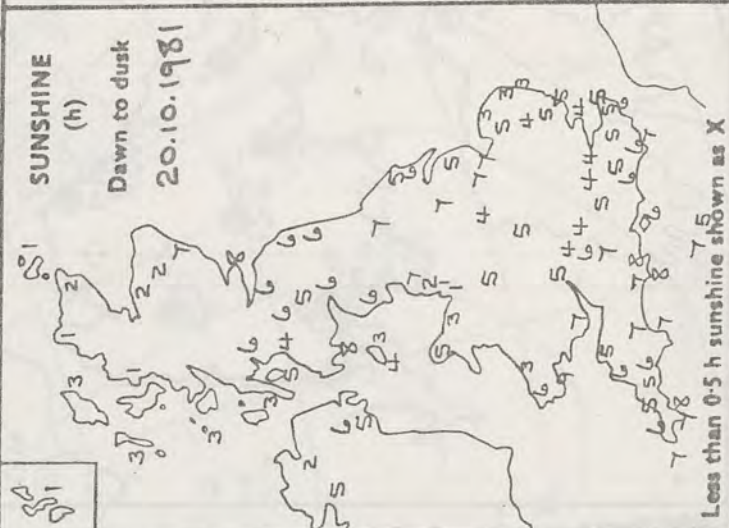


SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

Northern Ireland and parts of the west coast of Scotland had a rather cloudy day. SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

It was a cold day in most places but particularly in southern England where showers, moving from the west, merged into a fairly slow moving area of rain. The rain extended as far north as the south Midlands by late morning and reached London and the southeast in the early afternoon, finally clearing the east coast in the late evening. The rain was heavy in places with hail and thunder. All western areas had showers, but particularly West Wales and southwest England with hail and thunder and sleet on high ground. Much of north-east England and eastern Scotland, though, were dry with sunshine.

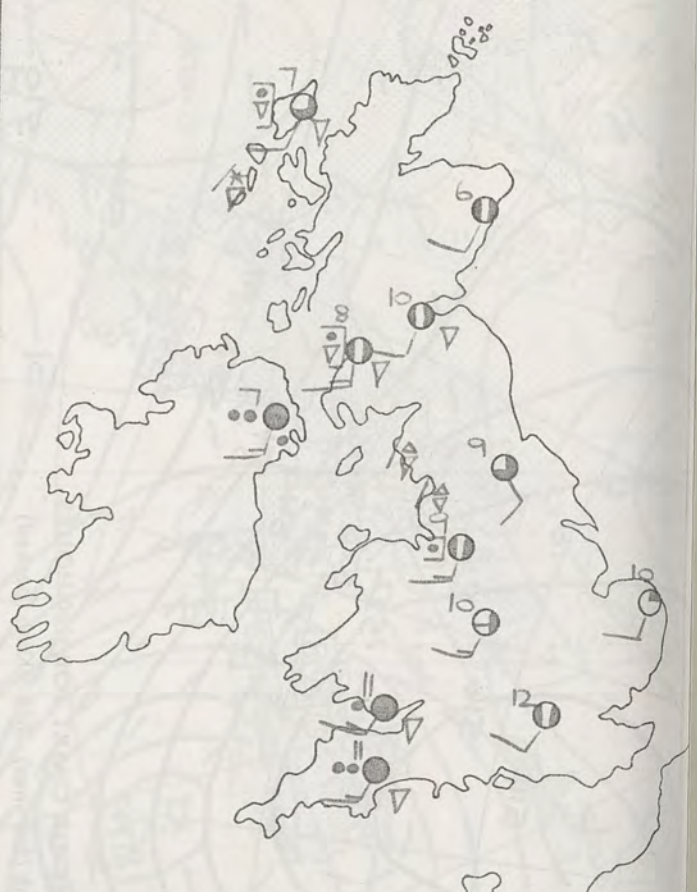
SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER

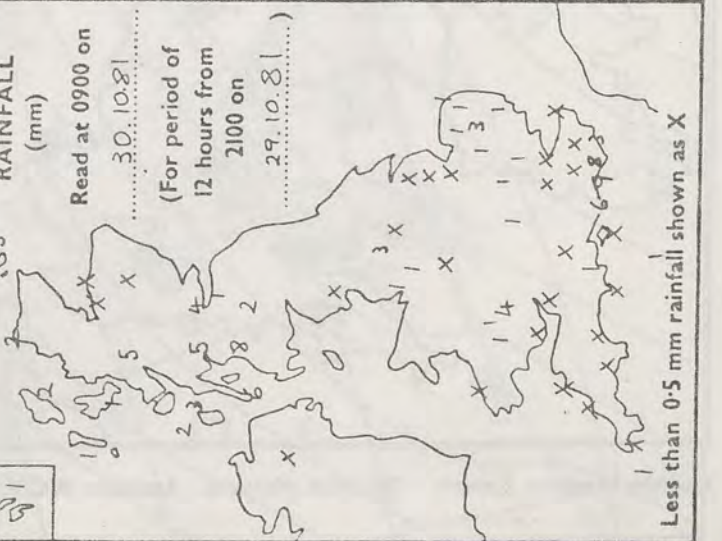
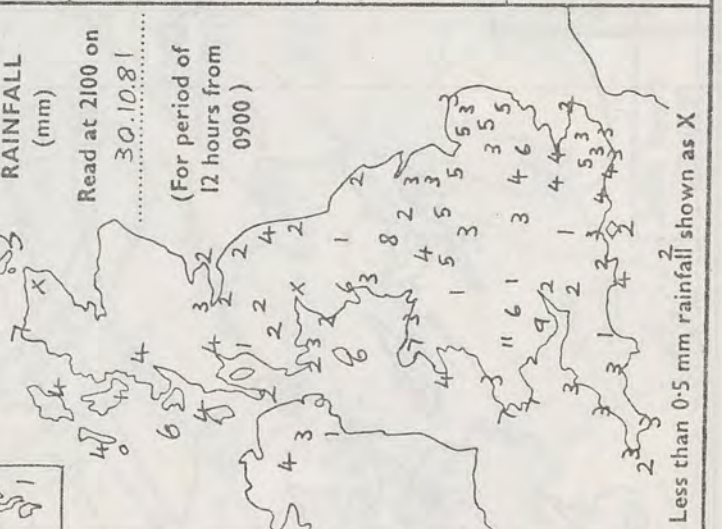
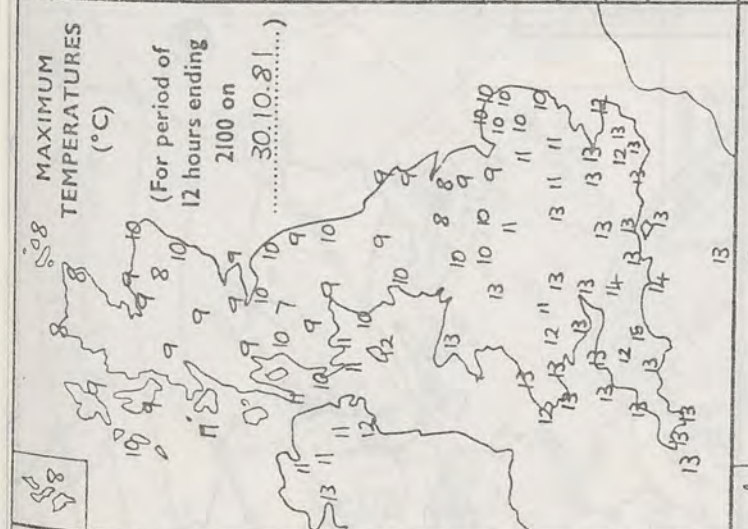




SUMMARY OF BRITISH WEATHER
