Headline:

Snow showers in far north extending southwards. Becoming progressively colder.

Today:

Rain in the far south clearing. Patchy fog across central areas slowly lifting, otherwise sunny spells. Many areas remaining dry, but snow showers will spread southwards in the north.

Tonight:

Snow showers in areas exposed to the north. Otherwise mostly dry, clear and very frosty.

Outlook for Tuesday:

Sunshine and snow showers. Some significant snowfall possible, especially in the north and east. Very cold.
