

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of rain and snow will clear southern England this morning, with an ice risk following. Then fine and cold for many, but with locally heavy, wintry showers in northern Scotland and along some eastern coastal areas. Temperatures will fall rapidly this evening, with a widespread frost overnight. A mixture of rain and snow arriving in the northwest later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cloud, wind and rain will spread southeastwards, with snow at times, especially over hills. Rain not reaching the far south and southeast until the evening. Strong northerly winds gradually easing on Friday, and showers tending to clear through the day.
