Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers and longer spells of rain will spread to all parts through the day, with any snow becoming confined to northern hills. It will be windy with widespread gales across England and Wales. The showers and winds should easing slightly through the night, with clear spells by dawn allowing patchy frost and ice. The rain will continue over northern parts.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday will still be windy, though less so than Saturday, with sunny spells and showers for most parts. More persistent rain will affect northwestern areas for a time. Rain, heavy at times, and strong winds will spread east on Monday.
