Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will be a dry, bright but cold day across much of England and Wales, with some sunny spells. However, further outbreaks of sleet and snow are likely across Scotland, Northern Ireland and northwest England. Also, westerly winds will be brisk across much of the country, which will add to the chilly feel.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
It will remain dry, bright and cold for the most part on Sunday with winds generally easing, but further wintry showers are likely to continue in the north. Then, through Monday it will become breezy across the country, with outbreaks of rain spreading from the west later.
