Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Cloudy in much of the country. Light drizzle will continue for most of the day in the north and east, slowly becoming lighter and more patchy in the afternoon. Some western areas, and also the far north of Scotland, may see some brighter spells in shelter from the increasingly brisk southeasterly wind. Feeling rather cold in the east and southeast.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday morning sees a band of rain moving east across the UK, patchy in the south but bringing a risk of sleet and snow to the north. Tuesday sees more rain, often heavy and persistent, working in from the west.
