Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Another very cold day across the UK, with strong easterly winds making it feel bitterly cold. Some bright spells, the best of which will be in the northwest, remaining largely overcast in the south. Dry for many, but a few mainly light snow showers will predominantly affect northeastern as well as central parts of the UK.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Remaining exceptionally cold on both Tuesday and Wednesday, although winds will ease a little. Scattered snow showers possible throughout, mainly affecting eastern and some central parts of the UK. Widespread, penetrating night frosts, locally severe, with the risk of icy stretches.
