Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Patchy mist or fog clearing, then variable, but often large amounts of cloud, this thick enough in places to bring a little rain or light showers, but these should die out later. Most places, however, should have some brightness with some pleasant sunshine for some.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Northwest Scotland will remain rather changeable and rather breezy with some rain at times. Elsewhere, the weather should be generally dry with some sunshine by day, but with an increasing risk of patchy fog forming overnight, that may linger into the morning. Temperatures should be near normal for mid September.
