Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fog in the south will slowly clear. Mainly cloudy but dry elsewhere with brightness emerging in some places this afternoon. Cloudier with rain in the far northwest. Rain arriving for most overnight, becoming heavy in particular across England and Wales. Turning drier with some showers across the far north later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain will gradually clear eastwards on Saturday and bright and breezy conditions will follow behind with heavy and blustery showers. Some showers will persist on Sunday but in general it will be a drier day with more sunshine and lighter winds. Feeling cold at the weekend, especially in the wind.
