

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 10 Apr 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A dry, sunny and warm day generally. It may feel cooler around coastal areas in sea breezes. Northern and western parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland will become cloudy, with some light rain today, turning heavy at times overnight. Cloud and light rain will spread to parts of Wales and southwest England by dawn.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain in the north and west may turn heavy at times, continuing to push southeastwards through Monday. This should weaken with only light rain over southern England by the afternoon. Brighter, cooler and breezier conditions will spread from the northwest with scattered showers continuing through Tuesday.
