Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mist and fog patches should readily lift to give good spells of sunshine for most, the sunshine made hazy at times by thin, high cloud. Parts of Scotland, mainly the north and northwest, will see thicker cloud and a few showers. Feeling very warm in the sunshine. Sunny for many this evening. Clear periods, and some patchy fog, overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A little rain affecting northern Scotland on both Saturday and Sunday but dry elsewhere with sunny spells, the best of the sunshine likely across Wales and western England. Pleasantly warm in the sunshine but cooler near some coasts.
