

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across eastern and northern areas will gradually clear northeastwards, although perhaps lingering across northern Scotland until evening. Drier and brighter elsewhere with sunny spells, and isolated heavy showers. Feeling warm, especially in the southeast, although breezy at times near coasts.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Largely dry and bright on Thursday with some long sunny periods. Showers are likely to develop, perhaps heavy, these most frequent in the north and west. Breezy in the north, however feeling warm, particularly towards the southeast. Often unsettled on Friday with further sunshine and showers, though a risk of more persistent rain in the south and east.
