

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A mix of rain and snow will affect many parts through the day. Snow amounts will be variable, but there is a risk of possible disruption across parts of England, Wales and eastern Scotland. Overnight, outbreaks of rain and snow continuing but generally becoming lighter in nature. Some clearer spells developing in places later leading to a few icy stretches.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A cold day on Monday, with outbreaks of light rain and snow across some parts, though easing later. Best of the dry and bright conditions across northern England. Remaining cold and largely cloudy Tuesday, with wintry showers in the east.
