Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Parts of northwest England, Wales and the Midlands may start rather grey and damp but it will brighten up a little, then all areas will see bright or sunny spells at times, but further heavy showers are likely, or perhaps a longer spell of rain over parts of Scotland. Still cool.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It'll be a dry start for many on Thursday with the chance of some sunshine but rain and strong winds will spread to most parts later in the day from the west. Blustery showers will follow on Friday, though northeasterern areas may see the rain linger for a while.
