

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of rain will work into western Scotland and Northern Ireland this afternoon, and push further southeast this evening and overnight. As it encounters the cold air across central, southern and eastern Scotland, there is a significant risk that freezing rain will develop. Elsewhere, remaining largely dry but very cold, with another severe frost in places tonight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

As the rainband continues south on Thursday, freezing rain is possible across northern England. By Friday, as the rainband reaches the Midlands, a period of snow looks likely to develop, possibly with some significant accumulations. Remaining very cold in the south.
