Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
There will be some locally heavy snow across southern and eastern England, especially during the morning, although as the day goes on this will become confined to southeastern England. Elsewhere, brighter with some sunshine, but cold. Scattered wintry showers will affect Northern Ireland and northern and western parts of both Scotland and Wales.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday there will be a mixture of sunshine and scattered wintry showers, these widespread across northern Scotland. Many central and southern areas will be dry. Similar in the north and east on Sunday, although rain preceded by snow will move into southern and western areas later.
