Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early cloud and rain across the far southeast of England will clear by mid morning to leave a dry and warm day with plenty of sunny spells. The best of the sunshine is likely to be around the coasts, where there will be gentle sea breezes. Otherwise winds will be light and it will feel warm.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will start bright for many but cloud will thicken bringing some rain across Scotland and Northern Ireland and a few showers across England and Wales. These showers will continue across the east on Friday, but elsewhere it should turn drier and brighter again.
