Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Light rain across parts of the northwest will die out on Friday morning and skies gradually brighten to leave the bulk of the day fine and dry. Further south the odd fog patch will clear to give another fine, dry day with sunny spells and a light breeze.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The weekend will remain dry for the UK apart from northwestern Scotland where a little rain is expected at times. Chilly by night with some patchy fog around, but this expected to melt away with some sunshine coming through. A brisk Easterly wind will develop along the South Coast during Sunday.
