Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Any rain and snow in southeastern areas will soon clear, and most places will then have a cold and windy day. Scattered showers will affect northern and eastern counties, and these may be wintry on hills. Southern and western areas will be largely dry with some sunny periods, and only a few, isolated showers.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will be windy with outbreaks of rain, perhaps snow, in the north on Saturday, but the south will be largely dry with some sunshine. The rain will move south across the UK on Sunday, with northern areas seeing some afternoon sunshine. It will stay cold.
