Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a frosty start, most places will see a dry and sunny day on Sunday. It will feel bitterly cold for many, particularly in brisk winds across southern parts. Isolated showers are possible across eastern England and in Shetland too.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will see another frosty start for many with plenty of sunshine for much of the UK, but skies will gradually cloud over in southern areas. Skies will turn cloudy for most parts by Tuesday, with patchy light drizzle possible and strengthening winds. It will feel very cold in the strength of the wind.
