

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain over Northern Ireland, Northern England and Southern Scotland, will turn to snow over Scottish hills this afternoon. It'll be mild for much of England and Wales, but heavy rain will push into western parts by evening. This squally rain will clear eastwards overnight, bringing hill snow for a time to parts of Southern Scotland and Northeast England.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Wintry showers in the north on Tuesday, but dry elsewhere until rain, sleet and hill snow spreads into Wales, Southern and Central England late in the day. On Wednesday sleet and snow clear from Wales and England, with wintry showers elsewhere.
