

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Heavy rain moves northwards through the morning, accompanied by strong winds with gales likely in the west, especially to exposed Irish Sea coasts. The southeast will see the driest day but it will be cloudy here. The rain will move away to the southeast into the evening, with the next band of rain arriving into the northwest later.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Unsettled at times with heavy rain mainly affecting the north and west. Further gales across many northern areas, with some sunshine to the far northeast. The wet and windy theme continues into Tuesday too. Staying mild despite the strong winds.
