Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A breezy day, particularly in the north, with gales in exposed parts of northern Scotland. There will be frequent showers in the north, with some of them falling as snow on Scottish hills. Further south, mainly dry with sunny spells and a few light showers on coasts. Rain in Northern Ireland in the afternoon, spreading to Scotland in the evening.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A breezy day again on Thursday with snow showers in northern Scotland, rain showers in the rest of Scotland and in Northern Ireland, and some light rain in England and Wales. Friday will be a more settled day across Britain.
