Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Much of England and Wales will be dry and very warm with sunny or clear spells. Elsewhere, rather cloudy with occasional breaks, most frequent in the east. Patchy, light rain and mist will affect western coasts and hills, especially western Scotland, and will spread over central Scotland during the night.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Very warm and dry with sunny spells in the south on Sunday. More cloudy to the north and west with rain moving across Scotland, then northern England. Sunniest in the far north and south on Monday with more cloud and the odd patch of rain in between. Staying warm.
