

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 09 Jul 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early low cloud and mist in some central and eastern parts should disperse more readily than Monday. Otherwise sunny and very warm again, although cloudier and cooler in northern Scotland. Staying dry overnight for many parts, however low cloud and perhaps patchy drizzle should spread inland from North Sea coasts, affecting many northern and eastern areas.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A little less warm than of late with a little more cloud around in the north and east on Wednesday, and then the south in turn on Thursday, although further sunny spells remain likely, especially in the west. Winds should remain generally light throughout.
