

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A band of rain will spread slowly southeast across the country, turning increasingly intermittent. Brighter skies will follow to Scotland and Northern Ireland, but with thundery showers in places later. Only southeastern parts of England look likely to remain dry, bright and warm, but it will be cooler elsewhere with mainly light southwesterly winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain is expected across southern England on Tuesday, with scattered showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland. It should be drier elsewhere though. Wednesday should be a mixture of scattered light showers and drier spells with breezy northwest winds. Temperatures will stay near normal.
