Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places seeing fairly cloudy skies today, though a few brighter spells will develop particularly over parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland after early mist and fog clears. Western parts of England and Wales should also fare best in terms of any brighter spells with the dullest conditions remaining in the east.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will see rain pushing into Scotland and Northern Ireland, while England and Wales, though still rather cloudy, should see a few brighter spells developing. Rain will affect many northern and western parts on Saturday, while the southeast stays largely dry.
