Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very windy today across the UK, and stormy in northeast Scotland. Cloud and occasional rain will extend to most areas before clearing southwards this afternoon, followed by colder, mainly drier conditions tonight. However, wintry showers persisting in the far north will result in some mountain snowfalls.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cloud increasing from the northwest during Friday, some rain mainly in the west and far north of Scotland, the southern half of the UK mostly dry with some early sunny breaks. By Saturday, cloudy conditions will extend throughout, with rain in the northern half of the country while again the south remains generally dry.
