Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Mainly dry and sunny after a frosty start today. Frequent, sometimes heavy, snow showers will continue over northern Scotland, especially the northeast, with more scattered wintry showers elsewhere, especially across N.Ireland and down western coasts. Cold.
Mainly dry, clear and frosty tonight. Further snow showers will affect northern Scotland. Wintry showers are likely over N.Ireland, western England and Wales.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Mainly dry, sunny and rather cold on Sunday. Wintry showers in the west, with snow showers, and possibly blizzards, over northern Scotland.

Plenty of dry, sunny but rather cold weather on Monday too with some wintry showers, mainly around the coasts.
