Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Most places will have a dry and chilly start to the day, although southern counties of England will be cloudy and windy with rain in places. The cloud, wind and rain will spread north across England and Wales through the day, with rain becoming heavy in places. Scotland and Northern Ireland will have a largely dry day with some sunshine.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

It will remain unsettled, with most parts of the UK likely to see showers or longer periods of rain, and only occasional brighter intervals. It will remain windy, with gales possible in some parts, and it will feel rather cold.
