

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Persistent and occasionally heavy rain in western Scotland will move eastwards during today. Other northern parts will see showers and patchy rain. It will be a sunny start for the south with the chance of isolated showers later. Southern and eastern areas will have a dry and clear night with patchy rain continuing in the north. Strong northwesterly winds.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Frequent scattered showers for many on Thursday but less widespread in the south. Further showers with plenty of sunny spells on Friday. Feeling cold, especially overnight with patchy ground frost expected in the north. Winds generally decreasing throughout the period.
