

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a chilly, but largely fine start across much of the UK, although southeastern parts will be rather cloudy, with some light showers here. As the day progresses outbreaks of rain, accompanied by strong winds will reach northwestern parts, before spreading southeast across the UK overnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Outbreaks of rain will clear southeast England during Wednesday afternoon, with a mixture of sunshine and showers spreading across the UK from the west, some of which will be wintry across northwestern areas. Thursday will be generally dry to start, but western parts will become increasingly cloudy, with some rain possible.
