Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
The far west, including Northern Ireland, should be mostly dry with some sunshine. Becoming dry over northern Scotland also. However, showery outbreaks of rain or sleet will affect eastern areas, spreading into central and southern parts of England and perhaps eastern Wales, with wet snow in places. Windy in many places, making it feel cold.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday will be dry in many areas, less cold, with some sunny spells. However, further snow showers are likely in far southeast England where it stays windy and cold. Monday becomes cloudier, perhaps rain showers in east, but most areas dry and a little milder.
