Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Tuesday:-Cloud and rain will spread southeast, except southeast England will remain dry and bright, once early mist/patchy fog clears. Broken cloud and scattered showers will follow from the northwest across N.Ireland and Scotland-showers mainly across north and west Scotland. Temperatures near normal.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday:-Bands of occasionally heavy rain will move east across the UK. Broken cloud and blustery showers will follow, plus fresh/strong northwest winds to western areas. Feeling cold with wind/rain.

Thursday:-Early mist/fog, mainly in the north, will clear. Becoming wet across the southwest, and parts of the south. Elsewhere sunshine and showers, the showers most frequent along Scottish coasts.
