Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Patchy fog across central areas clearing slowly, then many areas will be dry and for some, some bright spells are possible. However, heavy wintry showers are likely for the north and northwest, whilst southeast England remains dull and misty with further rain or drizzle at times.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Remaining generally cloudy with outbreaks of rain or showers, with the risk of hail or sleet in places. However, some western areas should have some bright or sunny spells. Staying cold with overnight frost. Later on Tuesday outbreaks of rain and hill snow will spread to some western areas on freshening southerly winds.
