

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places starting dry and bright, but rain will spread east across England, Wales and N.Ireland reaching E.Anglia by evening. Heavy showers will develop across Scotland. Tonight, Scotland, N.Ireland and northern parts of Wales and England will see further showers. The south should become drier, but also windy.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Much of the country will be rather cloudy and breezy with showery outbreaks. Some sunshine is likely particularly in the south and southwest, where it could stay largely dry. Scotland could see some rain on Saturday but the rest of Britain should have a drier and brighter day with lighter winds.
