

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 26 Oct 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Southern Britain starting cloudy with light rain but clearing from the north.  
Elsewhere, a bright and breezy day with cold northeasterly winds. Western areas  
mainly sunny but northern and eastern regions seeing cloudier periods and  
scattered wintry showers, with hail and possible thunder. Overnight, showers  
continuing in the north and east, wintry at first, but clear, cold and frosty  
elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, eastern areas seeing further wintry showers; further west, sunny  
but cold. Scotland and Northern Ireland becoming cloudier with rain spreading  
from the northwest, preceded by hill snow. On Sunday, wet and windy weather  
continuing southeastwards across most areas.
