

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 24 Jun 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain in the south and east clearing, then bright or sunny spells across much of the UK. Scattered showers developing, the heaviest likely in the north and east where there could be thunder. Winds easing from the west. Showers clearing this evening leaving a largely dry night with clear spells, though some patchy rain possible for northern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Light winds and sunny spells for many on Monday. A few showers are likely, largely in the north and east of the UK. Fine for many on Tuesday, but clouding over from the southwest through the afternoon, with some patchy rain later.
