Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Most places will have a dry and bright day with spells of sunshine, after any mist and fog patches lift and with winds significantly lighter than Monday. However, it will become cloudier in southwest England and Wales during the afternoon, with increasingly strong southeasterly winds bringing patchy rain later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Mild and unsettled, with strong southwesterly winds on Wednesday, pushing bands of rain northeastwards across the country. Becoming brighter and colder with sunny spells in northern parts on Thursday, but remaining mild, with outbreaks of rain in southern parts of the UK, although winds will ease considerably.
