Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
England and Wales will stay mostly dull with misty low cloud. Then rain will move from the northwest this afternoon into western regions before reaching other areas after dark and followed by clearer weather with scattered showers.
Otherwise much of Scotland and Northern Ireland can expect cloudy skies with rain arriving from the northwest today followed by clearer fresher weather reaching more western regions this afternoon and other areas this evening. Some showers will follow, especially to western and northern regions.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will turn colder with sunshine and wintry showers, but Sunday may bring rain or snow to the south.
