

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A grey start, especially across England and Wales, with mist and fog slowly lifting. Most places brighter and warmer by the afternoon, although fog will linger near some coasts. However thicker cloud across northwest Scotland will bring some rain, gradually edging into southern Scotland overnight. Elsewhere clearing skies will allow mist and fog to form again.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Another murky start on Friday, although the northwest will remain breezy with outbreaks of rain. The moderate breeze will spread southwards with thicker cloud into Saturday, however most places will stay dry. The best of the warm sunny spells will be in the southeast.
