

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 01 Mar 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mostly dry and mild, with cloudy periods and some sunny spells. However, far western parts will remain cloudier with occasional drizzle, whilst parts of Northern Ireland and Scotland should see occasional rain that will ease later. Staying mainly dry overnight, with a slight frost possible in prone spots. Northern and far western parts will remain cloudy, with occasional light rain.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday, morning rain in Scotland will clear to brighter conditions later. Elsewhere it should stay dry with some sunny spells, although southern parts will become increasingly cloudy. Becoming colder, wet and windy on Saturday, with rain moving through eastwards.
