

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Remaining fine, dry and very warm across the southeast today, whilst a rather cloudy day is expected elsewhere. There'll be some patchy rain across Wales and northern and western England, but fresher and brighter conditions are likely across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Persistent rain and strong winds will arrive from the west overnight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Fine and very warm once again in the far southeast on Friday, whilst wet and windy conditions persist in the northwest, gradually moving southeastwards. Rain should clear all areas by Saturday afternoon, with fresher, brighter and showery conditions following from the northwest.
