Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
During tomorrow morning, severe gales are possible for a time across Scotland, with localised heavy snowfall to follow in northern parts. Elsewhere it will be very windy with scattered showers and bright spells, although much of England and Wales should see some sunshine later in the afternoon.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

It will stay fairly windy and dry for most on Friday, but a spell of persistent snow is expected for parts of Scotland overnight. Saturday will be more unsettled with outbreaks of rain for many, but it will be less windy. Temperatures will be around normal, but cold in northern Scotland.
