

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and outbreaks of light rain will spread southwards across central parts of England and Wales, becoming drier again later. The south will remain largely dry and bright with some sunny spells once early morning mist and fog clears. Further north, many areas will have sunny spells, although showers will spread across western and northern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will be mainly dry over the south with sunny spells whilst showers with some longer spells of rain will spread across Northern Ireland and Scotland, then to Northern England and Wales later. Wet and windy at times in all areas on Tuesday.
