Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
N.Ireland and western Scotland will be windy with showers or rain,
locally heavy and persistent. Showers reaching central Scotland
later. Elsewhere largely dry and warm with sunny spells, but rather
cloudy in places, especially southwest England.
Mostly dry with late sunshine this evening, then clear spells
overnight. Showery rain will push north across western England,
Wales, and possibly the Midlands, overnight though.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cloudy with showers over N.Ireland and westernmost Britain on
Thursday. Otherwise mostly dry, sunny and warm or very warm. Largely
cloudy with some rain initially on Friday. Drier, sunnier conditions
spreading east through the day. Mostly rather warm.
