

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 10 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A weakening band of rain will move slowly southeastwards, reaching Wales and northern England by evening. It will be mostly dry and often sunny either side of the rain, but scattered heavy showers are expected across northwestern Scotland. Any remaining rain will fizzle out overnight leaving clear spells and patchy frost across northern parts of the UK.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Mostly dry on Friday with sunny spells and light winds, although stronger winds and outbreaks of rain are expected to reach northern Scotland by evening. This rain will spread slowly southeastwards on Saturday, turning lighter and patchier, with a fine day further south.
