

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 08 Jan 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A dry, bright and mild day for much of the UK, as lingering showers ease and become restricted to northwest Scotland. However rain and blustery winds move into the far southwest by midday, before spreading north across Wales and western England by dusk. These outbreaks then spread across much of the UK overnight, and also turn wintry over northern hills.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
The outbreaks of rain and strong winds will gradually clear eastwards through Thursday, leaving a drier and brighter day. However it will also turn colder, especially overnight with the risk of frost. However further rain quickly spreads east during Friday.
